Welcome to a new indoor season, we hope this will be an exciting year for our club following a successful renewal of a 35 year lease and refurbishment work done to build a new bar, update the viewing rails in the seated area and re-upholster the viewing area chairs. The club has a card payment machine at the bar any cashless transactions for membership fees, rink fees and bar usage.


Car Park situation update — please read

As many of you know, we had some challenges with the car park being extremely busy last season. Guildford Borough council have sent us the below official response, which we see as a very positive update for the club:

The draft outcome for Lido Road, which may still change, is that there will be enforcement between 8am and 6pm with four hours free parking. Self-managed permits will be issued to the bowls clubs that operate on any of our affected parks. These will be valid for individual days (dated) and annual permits will be issued for staff essential to run the club. The final outcome will be confirmed a minimum of 14 days prior to the Parking Order coming into force and after the car park refurbishment works.

Therefore use by members will largely remain unaffected as long as they display a valid permit where applicable – i.e use longer than 4 hours in the controlled period (8-6pm).

We are very confident that this will reduce the car parking challenges faced last season and we thank members for your patience whilst this has been resolved. The club will announce exactly what permits are in use in due course, once this has been formally agreed with the council.

Open Days & Coaching


Saturday 29th & Sunday 30th September
